Arrow Electronics, Inc. and/or one of our wholly owned subsidiaries (collectively, “Arrow”, “we” or “our”) are in receipt of your recent inquiry regarding SCIP (Substances of Concern In articles as such or in complex objects (Products)) established under the European Union’s Waste Framework Directive.

Arrow, as a distributor or assembler, complies with its obligations under REACH and the European Waste Framework Directive and its national implementing legislation by informing its customers in the European Union, in accordance with Art. 33(1) of the REACH Regulation, about substances of very high concern (SVHC) contained in our products in concentrations above 0.1% weight by weight. In addition, from 5 January 2021, Arrow will provide the information pursuant to Art. 33 (1) REACH Regulation to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), and thus comply with any SCIP obligations, if applicable.

Please be advised that our SCIP obligations to provide information pursuant to Art. 33 (1) REACH to ECHA does not affect your obligations and that Arrow will meet our own obligations under the new SCIP regime.
